During the semester, students are expected 85% attendance, active participation during the seminar, preparation of assigned group tasks (maximum 5 points). During the senester there will be two witten assignments a maximum of 20+20 points. For successful pass of the seminars is to be a minimum of 22 points, students who fail to collect the minimum points will not be allowed to take the exam. For final assessment, the student can choose two deadline exam. Correcting deadline of exam is possible to do verbal form.

Learning outcomes of the course unit:

Student will be able to communicate in the simple language situations, will be able to understand and express the basic ideas in communication and written form, understand and tolerate intercultural differences between different cultures. The student should be able to understand elementary grammatical structures and vocabulary, approximately 300 to 400 lexical items and simple conversation on current topics of everyday life. Designed communicative approach is specialized for communication skills, while neglect or other language skills, making use of the spiral form of the acquisition of knowledge. After successfully completing the learning process, the student should be survival in the country of the language studied.
