#### **Assesment methods:**

In the course of the semester there will be 2 written verification of 30 points: A rating - at least 55 points Rated B - at least 50 points, Assessment C - at least 45 points, Rating D - at least 40 points, Rated E - at least 35 points. Credits shall not be granted to a student who checks written from a yield of less than 10 points. At the end of the semester during the examination period: Test. The resulting evaluation - made diameter.

#### **Learning outcomes of the course unit:**

A student by completing the course will gain basic information on the possibilities of non-profit organizations establishment, basic information on the types of nonprofit organizations, on the activities and powers of non-profit organizations, methods of management, possibilities of obtaining financial resources for these organizations, the pursuit of business opportunities. Student will be able to explain the nature of the non-profit organizations, to explain the nature of their management and financing. Student will understand the governance of nonprofit organizations and accounting of non-profit organizations. After the successful completion of a learning process within that course student will be able to do analysis and statistics aimed at determining the effectiveness of non-profit organizations, evaluation of organizational reforming changes in the structure of non-profit organizations, as well as within the European context.

- 2. Legislation of non-profit organizations.
- 3. Bodies of NGOs and their privileges.
- 4. Governance and management of non-profit organizations.
- 5. Financing of non-profit organizations.
- 6. Financing of non-profit organizations from the perspective of the Law on Income Tax.
- 7. The management and business activities of non-profit organizations.
- 8. Accounting of non-profit organizations.
- 9. Accounting of non-profit organizations.
- 10. Ways of acquisition of non-profit organizations assets.
- 11. Possibilities to obtain financial resources.
- 12. Addressing the final work.
- 13. Free topics chosen by students. Consultation.
