Credits shall not be granted to a student who obtains a written clearance less than 5 points. At the end of the semester during the examination period: Project. Learning outcomes of the course unit: <i>Students by completing the course will gain an overview of the basic concepts of crisis management on crisis prevention, crisis situations and phenomena and their division. Next, to give an overview of the institutions and bodies of crisis management and the role of individual components of the Integrated Rescue System (IRS). Student will know the scope and role of central government authorities especially the Ministry of Internal affairs and the Ministry of Health, district offices and emergency responders - basic, other departments and police force and the causes of the crisis in the economic field and in the public sector. The student will understand the issue of crisis management in crisis management, issues and areas of economic mobilization and economic security of the state defense and information system issues in crisis management. After successful completion of a learning process under that course the student will be able to do the analysis and evaluation focused on the status and ability of management to manage the affairs of government in crisis situations, the IRS components for action in crisis situations and to assess the adequacy of IRS forces equipment and assets in the comparison within the V4 countries and optionally selected EU countries.</i>
