Learning outcomes of the course unit: <i>Students by completing the course will gain insight and knowledge of the theoretical basis of public administration as a discipline in pursuit of a rational arrangement in order to achieve greater effectiveness and efficiency in the implementation of public affairs and governance. Student should know the problems of public organization, its institutional structure, functions of public administration and principles of decision-making and administrative proceedings in public administration. The student should understand the economy and efficiency of public administration in consistency with reform in the European context, current issues of European public administration systems in EU states as well as issues of ethics and morality in public administration (corruption and the fight against corruption in public administration). After successful completion of the course student should be able to do analysis and statistics aimed at effectiveness determining in public administration, evaluation of reform and organizational changes in the public administration structure and conclusions on the overall state of public administration but also within the European context.</i>
