Assessment methods:

Student receives 50 points for the semester:

- Active participation in lectures and seminars
- Test / oral examination (50 points).

To get an A mark, the student needs to obtain at least 48 points, for B at least 44 points, for C at least 41 points, for D at least 38 points and for E at least 35 points.

Learning outcomes:

By studying the subject of kinesiotherapy in the clinical branches IV the student gains knowledge about etiology, pathogenesis of functional musculoskeletal disorders. He / she masters theoretical and practical basics of examination, diagnosis and treatment of the myoskeletal system malfunctions. He/she knows therapies applied in myoskeletal medicine, such as mobilization, traction and soft techniques applied to segments of vertebral column, root joints and peripheral joints.

Course contents:

Lectures:

- 1. Objectification of musculoskeletal system malfunctions.
- 2. Diagnosis and treatment of muscle imbalance.
- 3. Diagnosis of reflex changes in skin, subcutaneous tissue and fascia.
- 4. Reflex changes in muscles.
- 5. Articular blockade.
- 6. Principle and essence of mobilization techniques.
- 7. Use of breathing and sight at mobilization techniques.
- 8. Diagnosis of spinal blockades.
- 9. Diagnosis of articular blockades on peripheral joints.
- 10. Traction techniques.
- 11. Concatenation of malfunctions and influencing them by soft techniques.

Seminars:

- 1. Palpation techniques (physiological and pathological barrier).
- 2. Diagnosis and treatment of muscle imbalance.
- 3. Diagnosis and treatment of functional blockade of the axial system.
- 4. Diagnosis and treatment of functional blockades of limbs.
