Assessment methods: <i>To score 50 points per semester a student must:</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <i>Be actively present in the course – students are allowed two (2) free unexcused absences,</i> - <i>Pass a practical examination (50 points),</i> <i>To obtain A, a student must score 47, to obtain B, a student must score 42, to obtain C, a student must score 37 and more, to obtain D, a student must score 32, and to obtain E, a student must score 28. The credits are not granted to the students whose grade point average is 27 or lower.</i>	
Learning outcomes of the course unit: <i>By the completion of the course Lymphatic Drainage II, a student acquires knowledge and practical skills from manual lymphatic drainage. A student knows the mechanism of the effect of manual lymph drainage, knows its physiological and pathophysiological effects on the human body, its indications and contraindications, principles of application and a student can practically demonstrate massage strokes in lymphatic drainage.</i>
