Rules of multicultural/transcultural nursing from an ethic aspect.</i> 6. <i>Patient's rights from a multicultural aspect.</i> 7. <i>Specifics of multicultural nursing: verbal and non-verbal communication, communication barriers.</i> 8. <i>Specifics of social interaction in multicultural nursing.</i> 9. <i>Specifics in nutrition – culture as a nutrition influencing factor, brief characteristics of world cuisines (European, Asian, African, and American).</i> 10. <i>Specifics in spirituality satiation. Characteristics of some religions (Christianism, Judaism, Hinduism, Buddhism, and Islam).</i>
