<b>Degree of study:</b> I. (bachelor)	
<b>Course prerequisites:</b> - All compulsory and obligatory courses through the study (obtaining minimally 166 credits). - Practical state examination - The Bachelor's Thesis Defence	
<b>Assessment Methods:</b> Successful completion of practical state exams according to the study programme of ADU of Trenčín. If the Commission evaluates the practical part of the state examination as “poorly” – FX (requires further work), a student did not pass the state exam and can repeat the process only once.	
<b>Learning Outcomes of the Course Unit:</b> The graduates of the bachelor's degree programme Public Health – 1 <sup>st</sup> level, are able to: - Conduct national health supervision in the field of living and working environment, occupational health, in creating and protecting healthy living and working environment of children and youth, at work with ionizing radiation. - Conduct public health epidemiological surveillance and the resulting professional activities. Conduct the activities that are in accordance with the principles and concepts of National Health Policy and participate in health promotion programme implementation and health education projects.	
<b>Course Contents:</b> 1. National public health surveillance, definition, scope, access privileges, authorisation and status of persons conducting public health surveillance. 2. Organization and performance of public health in the Slovak Republic, structure, network and competencies of public health organs. 3. The role and organisation of the Ministry of Health in the field of public health. 4. The role and organisation of the Ministry of Health in the field of public health and public health organs' out of the field of health sector. 5. Performance of national public health surveillance at the regional administrative departments of public health, field of activity of Regional and Territorial Public Health (RÚVZ). 6. Specialized tasks of public health, national reference centres (CNRs). 7. Advisory and consultant's activity of health authorities. 8. Administrative action (administration, beginning, progress, end of the procedure, deadlines, appeals procedure). 9. Issue of measures (measures in place – prevention, measures in administrative	

actions), punitive measures (misdemeanors/indiscretions and other administrative offenses). Reimbursement of costs associated with the performance of national public health surveillance.

10. Professional competence, issue certificates, list of activities for which certificates are issued, commission activities.
11. National public health surveillance of drinking water. Hygienic requirements on drinking water.
12. National public health surveillance of bathing water. Hygienic requirements on bathing water.
13. National public health surveillance in accommodation facilities and in physical educational and sporting facilities. Hygiene indoor climate requirements on flats of lower standard and accommodation facilities and physical educational and sporting facilities.
14. National public health surveillance in health facilities. Hygiene requirements for their working/activity.
15. National public health surveillance in pre-school and school facilities of human body care. Hygiene requirements for their activity/working.
16. National public health surveillance in facilities for children and youth. Hygiene requirements for working of facilities for children and youth, and requirements for organising recreation activities and events for children and youth.
17. National public health surveillance in public health nutrition from caterers. Hygiene requirements for their working/activity.
18. Performance of national public health surveillance at the section of food safety, competence of health authorities, and other organs of public health in the official control of foodstuffs.
19. Hygienic requirements on food production, and placing of foodstuffs on the market of food, packaging, labelling, storage, transportation and sale (food law, Codex Alimentarius, good manufacturing practice, HACCP).
20. Responsibilities of Public Health at the controlling compliance with the law on funeral processions.
21. National public health surveillance at work, occupational health.
22. Competences of public health in relation to occupational health service (occupational health services, legal definition, the role, composition).
23. Risk assessment – safety and health at work and categorization of tasks (types of risk factors, measures – precautions to minimize their effects).
24. Obligations of the employer to ensure safety at work for employees.
25. Obligations of legal entities, individuals and communities in the field of public health.
