Course contents: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Medical dressing material, dressing (enveloping) techniques. Execution of basic dressing types of head, upper limb, lower limb, breast, and back. 2. Care of patient's bed. Bed types. Basic bed equipment. Additional bed equipment. 3. Care of adult patients and children hygiene. Prevention of intertrigo and pressure ulcer. 4. Dietary system. Manipulation with food on department. Preparation of natal alimentation in milk kitchen. 5. Excursion of the milk kitchen in the paediatric clinic of FH Trenčin. 6. Measurement and recording of vital functions. Measurement of temperature, pulse, breathes blood pressure. 7. Emission of urine – urination, catheterization. Care of patient with urine incontinency. 8. Faecal discharge – defecation, clyster. Care of patient with faecal incontinency. 9. Preparation and application of drugs. Drug forms and their marking. Drug ordering and management. Hand-on pharmacy. Directives for drugs application. Drug application techniques. 10. Preparation and application of drug per os. Application of drugs on skin, in eyes, ears, on nasal mucous membrane, and into breath ways. 11. Excursion to the internal/geriatric department of FH Trenčin. 	

12. Application of injections. General instruction to application of injections. Methodology of application of intracutan, subcutan injections.
13. Methodology of application of intramuscular injection.
