Learning outcomes of the course unit: <i>Students have basic language knowledge in the area of study at university and information about study in abroad as well as geographical and historical knowledge about their own country and the country, whose language they learn, based on the development of their writing, reading, listening and communication skills in Spanish/Russian/German language. Students are able to communicate in Spanish/Russian/German language about basic problems of education, their study at the university and know to introduce their country, where they live, and the country, which language they learn. Students acquire the basic vocabulary and grammatical structures used in selected topic areas. Students are able to use the language in communication and are prepared for basic study mobility.</i>
