<b>Assessment methods:</b> <i>There is a written test during the semester with total of 50 points, for marking A is a need to receive at least 75%, for marking B at least 70%, for marking C at least 65%, for marking D at least 60% and for marking E at least 50%. Students will not get credits, if they do not receive at least 50% from the written test.</i>	
<b>Learning outcomes of the course unit:</b> <i>Students have <b>broadened knowledge</b> of basic terms of public administration in Slovakia, its theory and historical development. They <b>are well acquainted with</b> the development of its functioning and content, structural as well as competence transformation. They also have broadened knowledge about the functioning of public administration in the past and impact of transformation and reforms of public administration on its current status.</i>
