Assessment methods:

Active participation in seminars (independent preparation on discussions according to instructions of lecturer and participation in discussions). Continuous assessment: active participation (not more than 2 allowed absences) and short presentation 20%. Final exam in form of written test: 80%.

Learning outcomes of the course unit:

By completing the course student has knowledge about theoretical basics of social protocol and its realization in practice. He/she **recognizes** the consequences of human behavior in society and also the importance of knowledge of its dimension and need of good human relations. He is familiarized with the social protocol in different situations and he/she **uses** it as a tool which helps to develop social skills in the realm of communication.

Course contents:

- 1. Introduction to the subject, assessment methods and goal of the subject.
- 2. Culture and protocol. Social and public relations.
- 3. Introduction, compellation and salutation. "Small talk".
- 4. Social meetings. Visiting cards. International relations.
- 5. Verbal communication. Written and oral, writing system. Making a call.
- 6. Non-verbal communication and culture.
- 7. Presents and courtesy, flowers.
- 8. Etiquette and non-etiquette. New Technologies.
- 9. Image. First impression.
- 10. Foreign policy of the Slovak republic.
- 11. Dining and behaviour by the table. Culture of drinking. Smoking.
- 12. Organization of events. Work in groups.
- 13. Written Test
