Assessment methods:

A student is getting assessment for the fulfilling of partial tasks given by a supervisor of a diploma thesis and consequently for the handed over diploma thesis. The course "Diploma thesis" also includes defending the diploma thesis which is a part of the state examination. Final defense assessment is usually a result of judgment of the supervisor, judgment of the thesis reviewer and defending the thesis in front of the state commission pursuant to the Educational Rules of the Trencin University of Alexander Dubcek in Trencin. A supervisor of diploma thesis takes into consideration an assessment of Defense Commission in evaluating the course "Diploma Thesis"

Learning outcomes of the course unit:

A student is **acquainted** with techniques of the citing and marking of bibliography references to avoid plagiarism. At the same time on the basis of lectures, he should **learn** the fundamental essentials of the diploma thesis, comprehend and know to create a clear and logical structure of an expert text. Last but not least, a **student** is expected to be able, in an exploratory part of his work, to use adequate methods of data collection and consequently to utilize them.

On the ground of cooperation with a supervisor, a **student** has also the improved and cleared structure of the thesis and the consulted scheduling of his activities till handing the thesis over.

The result of completing the course consists in the student's capability to hand over a final version of the diploma paper with all essentials which are prescribed in the Methodical Guidelines No. 56/2011 and internal documents of the Trencin University of Alexander Dubcek in Trencin and of the Political Science Department.

- 3. Theoretical paradigms
- 4. Data collection methods I.
- 5. Data collection methods II.

- 7. Essentials of various parts of an expert text
- 8. Formulation of goals, research issues and hypotheses
- 9. Methods of data processing
- 10. Presentation of findings or outcomes
- 11. Techniques of the citing, writing bibliography references

- 12. Formal layout of the expert text
- 13. Structured interview and discussion
